

2. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Section 10-13 and Section 10-14 of the School Code indicate that a **president**, **vice president** and **secretary** shall be elected by the members of the Board of Education and those individuals shall serve for two years, except that the Board by resolution may establish a policy for the term of office to be one year. The District 200 Board has adopted a policy establishing the term of office for the three officers at one year. It is not necessary to adopt another resolution.

- The president pro tempore will entertain nominations for president.
 - The nomination for president will be approved by a roll call vote.
 - After the president is elected, he or she will conduct the remainder of the meeting.

- In the absence of the president elect, the president pro tempore will entertain nominations for vice-president.
 - The nomination for vice-president will be approved by a roll call vote.
 - After the vice-president is elected, he or she will conduct the remainder of the meeting.

- The president elect or vice-president elect will entertain nominations for secretary.
 - The nomination for secretary will be approved by a roll call vote.
