

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE MCKINNEY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT
REGARDING HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS**

WHEREAS, Education Code §48.151(d) allows the Board of Trustees of McKinney Independent School District to obtain supplemental state funding for transporting regular, otherwise ineligible students who live within two miles of their school but who would be subject to hazardous traffic conditions if they walked to school; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) School Transportation Allotment Handbook, and McKinney ISD Board policy CNA(LEGAL) and CAN(LOCAL) require the Board to adopt language providing the definition of hazardous traffic conditions applicable to the District and identifying the specific hazardous areas for which such funding is requested; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the Education Code § 48.151(d) provisions stating that a hazardous condition exists where no walkway is provided AND students must walk along or cross a freeway or expressway, an underpass, an overpass or a bridge, an uncontrolled major traffic artery, an industrial or commercial area, or another comparable condition; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges that hazardous conditions will differ for Elementary, Middle and High School students;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Trustees of McKinney Independent School District has determined that hazardous conditions exists in the same manner as stated in Education Code § 48.151(d) and has identified the following specific hazardous areas to be eligible:

1. Walking along or crossing US Highway 75 / Central Expressway
2. Walking along or crossing US Highway 380 / E University Dr
3. Walking along or crossing State Highway 5 / McDonald St
4. Walking along or crossing State Highway 121 / Sam Rayburn Tollway
5. Walking along or crossing Virginia Parkway east of Jordan Road and west of US Highway 75
6. Walking along Collin McKinney Parkway south of Orion McKinney Apartments and north of McKinney Ranch Parkway
7. Walking along McKinney Ranch Parkway east of Kathryn Way and west of Quail Wood Drive
8. Walking along Craig Drive east of El Lago Apartments and west of Collin McKinney Parkway
9. Crossing Lake Forest Drive at Virginia Parkway (Elementary Only)
10. Crossing Wilmeth Road, east of Taylor Burk Drive and west of South Hardin Boulevard and including the intersections of Taylor Burk Drive and Wilmeth Road and South Hardin Boulevard and Wilmeth Road (Elementary Only)

- 11. Crossing Trinity Falls Parkway south of Collin County Outer Loop and north of Farm to Market 543 / Weston Road
- 12. Crossing Olympic Crossing at Sweetwater Cove
- 13. Crossing Parkland Crescent at Sweetwater Cove
