




622 Online Enrollment: New Eligibility Standards

Why this change? Full-time asynchronous online learning requires strong self-direction, time management, and consistent engagement. The Board established these criteria to ensure students enrolling in 622 Online are positioned for success — and to connect those needing additional support with the right resources before they fall behind.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (ALL THREE MUST BE MET)

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1 Student applies** to 622 Online and submits required documentation.
- 2 Review team** — administrators, counselors, and/or licensed educators — evaluates the application.
- 3 Decision issued:** approved, conditionally enrolled, or referred to an alternative learning option.
- 4 Notification** sent to student and family with next steps.

WAIVER / APPEAL OPTION

Students not meeting one or more criteria may appeal within **10 school days** of notification. Submit a written explanation with supporting documentation (medical, personal, or family circumstances).

Conditional enrollment may include:

- Academic probation
- Mandatory in-person check-ins or mentoring
- Credit recovery planning
- Attendance monitoring

ASCEND HIGH SCHOOL

Students not meeting one or more criteria should consider our alternative high school (Ascend) which combines online curriculum with in-person supports.

CONTINUING ENROLLMENT STANDARDS

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Maintain 2.5 GPA (modified by IEP or support plan if applicable)

ENGAGEMENT

Regular attendance and active participation required each term

GRADUATION PROGRESS

Must meet graduation milestones each term or may be transitioned to another setting

Compliance: This resolution is implemented in compliance with IDEA, Section 504, and the ADA. Students with IEPs or 504 Plans will receive appropriate accommodations and services.
