Subject: K-5 Math Curriculum Adoption

Background Information

During the 2025-2026 school year, Midway ISD's Teaching and Learning Department has led the district through the process of adopting new K-5 mathematics curriculum. The process was a thorough one that included the following steps:

1. In the fall, the district began a pilot process for Amplify Math + Desmos in grades 3 – 5.
2. District mathematics leaders vetted all curriculum currently approved by the Texas State Board of Education.
3. Teachers were provided access to the five approved curricula: Amplify Math + Desmos, Bluebonnet Learning, enVision Texas Mathematics, i-Ready, and Stemscoopes.
4. A vendor showcase was held on April 4 with both teachers and community members invited to view each of the five options for adoption.
5. A survey was sent to staff to select the top choices to be adopted for the the 2026 – 2027 school year. Amplify Math + Desmos was the number one selection with 70% of participants choosing it as their first choice.
6. Comments by staff members noted the rigor, TEKS alignment, and user-friendly interface among the top reasons for selecting this curriculum.

Fiscal implications

Once the quote is generated by Amplify, the curriculum will be ordered using IMAT (Instructional Materials and Technology) funds through the SBOE-Approved Instructional Materials Entitlement.

Administration Recommendation

District administration recommends the consent to move forward with the K-5 adoption.
