Report – June 2026

Classes

- We held Tiger Cub Basketball on a few Saturdays in January/February. 43 students participated. Coach Noble and Coach Boehning split the instruction along with some Varsity/JV basketball players just like the last few years. The kids all had a great time.
- From March-May we ran an Early Acting Class for 4th-6th Graders. Vera Scheer and Lorann Skorr were the instructors with supervision from Mrs. Scheer. 20 students took the class. The class ran Tuesdays & Thursdays after school. It went very well.
- Tess Christenson offered 3 classes for June. 2 of these classes were cancelled because of low numbers. We are still trying to get the 3rd class to run. They were a Fairy House Craft, Wind Chime Creations and Build & Decorate a Birdhouse.
- Breanna Scheer is offering a Summer Stage Camp for those students entering 4th-6th Grade. That class is scheduled for Monday, July 6th – Friday, July 10th.
