From the beginning to the end of the year, enrollment decreased by 68 students.

All principals have completed their school close out and are done for this summer. They begin on July 27 with in-service.

The instructional leadership team has been finalizing the in-service schedule for all staff at the beginning of next year. Principals will come in for their in-service. New teachers will also come in for in-service. Whole staff in-service training will happen at sites.

The Physical and Earth Science curriculum—grounded in Native ways of knowing, language, and culture and designed through place-based learning—is nearing completion for pilot implementation. During the upcoming year, the curriculum will be in draft form as three sites implement and provide feedback on the pilot.
