REPORTING CHILD ABUSE - CHILD PROTECTION

All employees and volunteers, regardless of whether they are licensed, ~~School personnel, including substitute staff,~~ having knowledge of or reasonable cause to suspect that a child is being abused or neglected shall report the circumstances to the appropriate social services agency or law enforcement agencies within 24 hours. Information about child abuse and neglect and how to report suspected or questionable situations will be provided to all regular and substitute staff, and volunteers.

Failure to report or supply information concerning suspected abuse or neglect willfully is a Class B misdemeanor and also subjects the staff member to disciplinary action within the work place.
