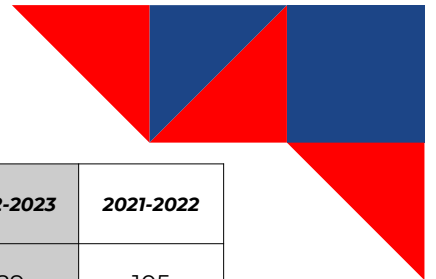

## Historical Data - Transfers IN vs OUT

<b>School Year</b>	<b>Transfers IN</b>	<b>Transfers OUT</b>	<b>Out to In</b>
2021-2022	263	432	1.64
2022-2023	314	501	1.60
2023-2024	349	501	1.44
2024-2025	331	497	1.50
2025-2026	374	527	1.41

At the 21-22 rate of 1.64 this would be **614**.

## FDA (LOCAL) - Transfer Criteria

Transfers are approved on a year to year basis

1. The availability of space and instructional staff.
2. The student's disciplinary and criminal record.
3. The student's attendance record. Less than 90% attendance will disqualify a student.
4. Satisfactory academic progress during the previous school year. The student must perform at or above grade level for the previous school year.

## ***Changes to FDA (LOCAL)***

July 22, 2025

Students PK-11 who become nonresidents may remain enrolled through the end of the grading period. Those students must apply for and meet the criteria in FDA(LOCAL) to remain enrolled in MISD.

January 20, 2026

Removed the transfer fee beginning with the 26-27 school year. The transfer fee has been \$1,000.



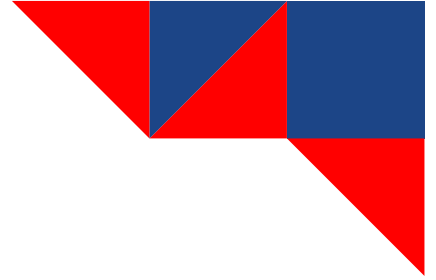
