Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?

This board report is requesting that MAP Growth testing be selected for Three Rivers School District as the assessment to satisfy Senate Bill 141. Per the Education Accountability Act, each district must select one English Language Arts and one math assessment from the approved list. These assessments must be given to all students three times per year and the results regularly shared with the board. Currently, our students take the MAP Growth math assessment, we will just be adding the English Language Arts assessment.

Provide history/background information on your proposal:

SB 141, the 2025 Education Accountability Act, includes new requirements related to interim tests in math and English language arts for grades K-8. Under the bill, school districts and charter schools must:

**Administer interim tests in math and language arts three times per year in grades K-8.

**Select tests from the State Board of Education-adopted list.

**Review interim test data at least three times per year with administrators from each school, and during a public meeting with the superintendent and school board.

List the advantages of your proposal:

Senate Bill 141 requires that all students K-8 take these assessments, however Three Rivers will be administering the assessments K-12 to gather additional data to support and inform classroom instruction.

List possible disadvantages of your proposal:

Senate Bill 141 is required for all school districts. By not approving this request, it would put the district in violation of the Education Accountability Act.
