ARREST-CONVICTION OF CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES

A classified employee is required to report to the Superintendent/**Designee** or Human Resources Director if he/she has been arrested or convicted of a crime within two District business days after arrest or conviction. The crimes an employee is required to report include:

- Any felony;
- Any gross misdemeanor;
- Any misdemeanor involving drugs, sex crimes, child abuse or spousal abuse;
- Any DUI if driving is a condition of employment.
