BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On May 4, 2026, Levelland ISD had its three-year safety and security audit conducted by Mr. David Cox, an approved auditor contracted with the Region 17 Educator Service Center. The audit is a requirement of TEC §37.108, which states “At least once every three years, each school district shall conduct a safety and security audit of the district’s facilities. To the extent possible, a district follows safety and security audit procedures developed by the Texas School Safety Center or a comparable public or private entity.”

Audits should be an ongoing process with the aim of identifying hazards, threats and vulnerabilities that might pose a danger to life or property and may interfere with a safe, secure and healthy school environment that is conducive to teaching and learning.

The Safety and Security Audit include: Physical Security Assessments, Intruder Assessments, Emergency Operations Plan, School Climate Surveys, and Trainings and Drills.
