BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The district instructional data dashboard provides the district with a systematic process for gathering multiple data points to track implementation levels of the district instructional focus areas and to monitor student progress data throughout the school year.
- The Curriculum & Instruction Department will provide the Board with a math teaching and learning update.
- During the 2025–2026 school year, the Math Department has focused on bridging achievement gaps in mathematics, enhancing student engagement, and strengthening overall student outcomes as follows:
 - Curriculum Writing: Ensures that math instruction is cohesive, standards-aligned, and intentionally designed.
 - Culture Building in Math: Promotes a positive and collaborative learning environment by fostering sociomathematical norms and shared beliefs about productive struggle through professional learning.
 - Professional Learning: Implementing instructional strategies aimed at igniting curiosity and active participation.
 - 26-27 Math Adoption Process: Establishes a high-quality, standards-aligned instructional framework through a collaborative review process, incorporating stakeholder feedback and a strategic implementation plan.
