Funding Source	Title	General Purpose
STATE	Breakfast after the Bell (BATB)	The Breakfast After the Bell Equipment Grant provides reimbursement to grantees for the purchase of equipment used in the Breakfast After the Bell program. Breakfast After the Bell is required for all school sites that meet the eligibility guidelines as stated in Oregon Administrative Rule ("OAR") 581-051-0605, and are not eligible for nor claim an exemption.
STATE	Farm to CNP Base AY25	The ODE Farm to CNP Noncompetitive Reimbursement Grant aims to increase Grantee's purchasing power to include more local food purchases in applicable feeding program meals; and benefit the State economy.
STATE	SIA 2025-2027	The purpose of this grant is to provide funding to assist in meeting students' mental and behavioral health needs, increase academic achievement, and reduce academic disparities for student populations identified in ORS 327.180(2)(b). These populations include, but are not limited to, economically disadvantaged students, students from racial or ethnic groups that have historically experienced academic disparities, students with disabilities, English language learners, students who are homeless, and student who are foster children, and any other student groups that have historically experienced academic disparities, as determined by the State Board of Education by rule.
STATE	Early Literacy Success 25-27 Yr 1	The purpose of this Grant is to provide funding to assist in increasing early literacy from birth to grade three; to reduce literacy-related academic disparities for student groups that have historically experienced academic disparities; to increase support to parents and guardians as partners in the development of their children's literacy skills and knowledge; and to increase access to early literacy learning through supports that are research-aligned, culturally responsible, student-centered, and family-centered.
STATE	Early Indicator Intervention 2025-2027 Year 1	The purpose of this Grant is to provide funding to implement and maintain an Early Indicator and Intervention System aligning school, district, and community systems in order to help students stay on track to graduate from high school.

STATE	High School Success 2025-2026 Year 1	The purpose of this Grant is to provide funding to establish or expand programs related to dropout prevention, career and technical education, and college-level educational opportunities for high school students (each, a "Student").
STATE	Secondary Career Pathways 2025-27	The purpose of the Grant is to provide Secondary Career Pathways (SCP) funding to Eligible Secondary Education Providers to maintain and enhance approved Career and Technical Education Programs of Study (CTE POS) that lead to High-Wage, High-Demand jobs in accordance with ORS 327.372.
STATE	Tribal Attendance Promising Practices	The purpose of this Grant is to reduce Chronic Absenteeism for all students and strengthen links between the Tribes and the Schools that serve Enrolled Tribal Members.
STATE	Preschool Promise 2025-2027	The Preschool Promise (PSP) program was created as a model for a publicly-funded, high-quality preschool system. This Grant provides funding for PSP programs administered by the Grantee.
STATE	SeismicRehabilitation - North Bay Elementary	Recipient shall design and construct a seismic rehabilitation project for its North Bay Elementary Gym to bring the building to the Basic Performance Objective for Existing Risk Category IV buildings, including but not limited to structural and non-structural deficiencies of the building.
FEDERAL	Title I-A 24-25	The purpose of Title 1 funds is to provide supplemental financial assistance to schools with high percentages of low-income families. These federal funds aim to ensure all children have access to a high-quality education and to close academic achievement gaps by supporting disadvantaged and at-risk students. North Bend is using these funds primarily to provide supplemental instructional support and intervention to students not meeting grade level benchmarks in the areas of reading, writing, math and Kindergarten readiness skills.
