NSBSD Policy Manual:

Board Bylaw 9140, Board Representatives: The Board may appoint any of its members to serve... as its representative to other public agencies or organizations when the Board deems such appointments desirable, contingent on acceptance of the appointment by the member.

NSBSD Strategic Plan Summary:

1.0 Prioritize and implement intentional and purposeful partnerships.

Issue Summary:

The Board may nominate its member(s) to the Association of Alaska School Board (AASB) Board of Director's upcoming vacant seats through formal action. The deadline to submit nominations are October 22, 2025.

Members for the Board of Directors are elected at-large by the Delegate Assembly to serve a 3-year term. Currently, Board Clerk Frieda Nageak is a member on the AASB Board of Directors. If a Board member is nominated and accepts the nomination, they must complete the nomination form included on the aasb.org nominations submissions website providing a written statement detailing their views on:

- The appropriate role of the AASB;
- The major issues facing AASB in the near future;
- How AASB could better serve school boards; and,
- Ways AASB can help school boards meet Board Standards.

The Board member nominated will participate in a virtual interview with the nominating committee in early November, and once selected must attend the Annual Conference and deliver a 2-minute speech to the membership on Saturday, November 15. If elected, they must attend the AASB Board of Directors meeting on Monday, November 17.

Background:

The Association of Alaska School Boards (AASB) Board of Directors is made up of fifteen (15) member school board members who govern AASB for the benefit of all the member districts. Nominations require formal action by each members School Board as their participation requires the District to cover the cost of travel to the Annual Conference, Spring Board Meeting, and Spring Fly-in.
