STUDENT DISCIPLINE

Nye County School District (NCS D) is an agent of the public and has a basic responsibility to help the parent/legal guardian educate, guide, and when necessary, discipline his/her student. In the final analysis, however, these basic responsibilities rest with parents/legal guardians and, if they fail, the State.

Students have a responsibility to behave in a manner appropriate to good citizenship everywhere. All students shall receive at the beginning of each school year, the Parent/Student Handbook listing the rules and regulations to which they are subject.

Although student discipline should emphasize the development of self-discipline, it is recognized that there are instances when it is necessary to administer disciplinary measures. These measures and the manner in which they are administered shall be consistent with the objective of creating a positive learning situation and fostering self-discipline.

In no instance shall repeated infractions or abuses of school regulations be handled without involving the parents/legal guardians of the offender. Every reasonable attempt will be made to notify the parents/legal guardians prior to serious disciplinary measures being initiated.
