**Background Information:** As part of the previously approved opening Furniture, Fixtures, and Equipment (FFE) purchases, administration is requesting Board approval for a purchase from Tarpley Music Company in an amount exceeding \$100,000.00. This purchase is necessary to provide the instruments and related equipment required to establish and support the 6th grade band program at Willard Middle School. Approval of this purchase will ensure the campus is fully equipped to provide band instruction and student participation opportunities upon opening.

**Budgetary Impact:** This proposal seeks approval for purchases for instructional materials exceeding \$100,000.00 from a single vendor. This purchase will be made from previously approved FFE funds.
