DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

At the direction of the Board of Trustees, the Superintendent shall appoint a District Disciplinary Hearing Officer to conduct hearings and make decisions concerning long-term suspension or expulsion of a student. Pursuant to NRS 392.467, all district disciplinary hearings shall be closed to the public. The Hearing Officer shall attempt to schedule each hearing as soon as reasonably possible after receipt of notice and request for hearing from a school.

The Hearing Officer, principal, parent/legal guardian and student will each agree to, sign and receive a copy of The Student Disciplinary Action Form at the hearing. A copy of this form will be placed in the student's disciplinary file.
