**Background Information:** A proposal from Follett Content Solutions for the procurement of library materials and related resources to support district library programs is being presented. The proposed purchase is aligned with the legislative requirements set forth in Texas Administrative Code, Title 13, Part I, Chapter 4, Section 33.021, as established by the Texas State Library and Archives Commission, which are intended to promote excellence in literacy and support the development of strong foundational academic skills for all learners. During the March Regular Board Meeting, the Board approved the procurement list brought forth by the School Library Advisory Council (SLAC).

The proposed purchase includes library books, makerspace materials, book repair supplies, and library technology resources for multiple campuses, including Martin Elementary, Bothwell Elementary, Celina High School, and the opening collection for Willard Middle School. The proposed quotes for each campus include:

- Martin Elementary School- not to exceed \$98,300.00
- Bothwell Elementary School- not to exceed \$78,300.00
- Celina High School- not to exceed \$92,100.00
- Willard Middle School- not to exceed \$141,600

**Policy:** CH(LEGAL)

**Budgetary Impact:** This proposal seeks approval for purchases for library instructional materials exceeding \$100,000.00 from a single vendor. This purchase will be made from previously approved FFE funds.

**Recommendation:** The District recommendation is for the Members of the Board to approve the purchase of library instructional materials from Follett Content Solutions not to exceed \$410,300.00.
