**Summary:**

This update outlines the progress and logistical milestones regarding the consolidation of Bransford and Dove Elementary Schools. As we shift from the packing and labeling phase to the physical relocation of instructional materials and facility preparations at our receiving campuses, our primary focus remains on ensuring a seamless and supportive transition for all students and staff.

The staff of Bransford Elementary School and Dove Elementary School have worked hard and done a great job of packing and labeling their classroom instructional materials and equipment, office records and materials, and related items for moving.

The Facility Services Department, along with assistance from other operational services staff, identified and labeled furniture at Bransford and Dove that will be moved to other schools.

The District hired a moving company to move the items described to Silver Lake, Cannon, Colleyville, and O.C. Taylor Elementary Schools. The District's Facility Services Department will be moving Bransford and Dove staff who are moving to other District schools.

The District recognizes and is grateful for the assistance of Dad's Club members and other volunteers that have assisted teachers and others to prepare for the move and/or move personal items for staff.

The District has communicated and made available, four Tuesdays in July for staff who want to unpack and setup classrooms before returning in August, except for those moving to O.C. Taylor because that campus is undergoing construction.

Contractors are scheduled to replace carpeting with tile flooring in a special education classroom at Colleville Elementary School for, remove a wall between two special education resource rooms at Cannon Elementary, and move the special education play equipment from Bransford to Colleyville Elementary.

All elementary campuses have at least one RISE classroom and Colleyville Elementary will serve medically assisted students within the RISE setting as previously experienced at Bransford.

District planning also includes taking inventory, ongoing maintenance of systems, and regular on-site presence at the campuses.

The District received notice from the Texas Education Agency of the committee's final approval to make the school numbers for Bransford and Dove obsolete with the agency.

Lowery Property Appraisers was contracted to provide a complete market value appraisal report on three properties, which include Heritage Annex, Dove Elementary School, and the Professional Development and Education Center. The appraisal report will include a highest and best use analysis of the properties.
