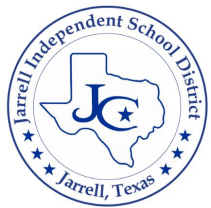

# Purpose & Overview

- Twenty (20) seats will be available for students in grades 11 and 12.
- Support students who benefit from a more self-paced approach.
- Blend in-person and online learning.
- Majority of coursework is provided by Imagine Learning and completed online, with options for onsite and online course offerings.
- Students must take at least one class on campus.



# Enrollment & Eligibility

- Electronic Application
- Eligibility Considerations:
  - Student is currently enrolled with Jarrell ISD or resides within Jarrell ISD Attendance Boundaries.
  - Transfers will be considered using same standards for transfer enrollment as a traditional student per Board Policy FDA (Legal).
  - Student is in good standing for attendance, behavior and academics.
  - Student completed the required number of grade level credits; and
  - Met requirements for End of Course State Assessments as applicable.
  - Student is CCMR Complete.

# Attendance, Discipline and Academic Accountability

Students enrolled in Jarrell ISD's Hybrid Learning Program are held accountable to all standards outlined in Board Policy and the Student Code of Conduct for attendance, discipline and academic accountability.
