LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT
OF
KATHRYN RAMONA CARPENTER

I, Kathryn Ramona Carpenter, of the City of Princeton, County of Mille Lacs, State of Minnesota, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, and do hereby revoke all former Wills and Codicils made by me.

ARTICLE ONE

PAYMENT OF EXPENSES AND TAXES

1. My personal representative shall pay from the residue of my estate:
 - 1.1 the expenses of my last illness and funeral, valid debts, expenses of administering my estate, including non-probate assets;

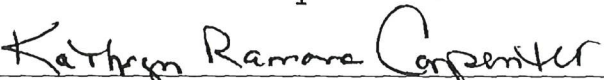
ARTICLE TWO
SPECIAL GIFTS

2. I make the following special gifts:
 - 2.1 I give all of my tangible personal property pursuant to a written list I will attach hereto. LeeAnn Sanborn shall distribute said items.

ARTICLE THREE

RESIDUE

3. I give the residue of my estate, consisting of all the property I can distribute by will and not effectively distributed by the preceding provisions of this will, except any property over which I then have a testamentary power of appointment, as follows:
 - 3.1 One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) shall be set aside for Julie Hansen to use to care for and rehome my beloved cat;
 - 3.2 Fifty percent (50%) of the remainder of my estate as follows: Thirty percent (30%) in two (2) equal shares to the Milaca Scholarship Foundation and the Princeton Scholarship Foundation; and twenty

- percent (20%) to Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Princeton. The money gifted to the Scholarship Foundations shall be used, to the extent possible, for agricultural and healthcare related scholarships.
- 3.3 The remaining fifty percent (50%) of my the remainder of my estate shall be divided equally between the following: Troy Carpenter, Julie Hansen, Shawn Rouselow, and Jamie Rouselow.
- 3.4 If not disposed of by the preceding paragraphs, to my heirs-at-law, who shall be determined under, and take the shares prescribed by, Minnesota statutes of intestate succession in force at the execution of this will, applied as if I had died intestate.

ARTICLE FOUR FIDUCIARY SELECTION

4. The following provisions shall apply to the selection of fiduciaries:

- 4.1 My personal representative shall be selected as follows:
- 4.1.1 I nominate LeeAnn Sanborn as my personal representative.
- 4.1.2 LeeAnn Sanborn shall have the power to nominate an additional or a successor personal representative.

ARTICLE FIVE FIDUCIARY PROVISIONS

5. The following shall apply to my fiduciaries:

- 5.1 **Administrative Powers.** My personal representative, in addition to all other powers conferred by law that are not inconsistent with those contained in this will, shall have the power, exercisable without authorization of any court:
- 5.2 **Informal Administration.** I request that my estate be administered in as informal a manner as my personal representative deems advisable.
- 5.3 **Waiver of Bonds.** No bond or other indemnity shall be required of any personal representative nominated or appointed by my spouse or me.

ARTICLE SIX

GENERAL GOVERNING PROVISIONS

6. In applying the provision of this document, the following shall govern:

6.1 Rules of Construction

6.2.1 Governing Law. Except as altered by this will, the law of Minnesota shall govern the meaning and legal effect of this will and the administration of my estate. Except as otherwise provided, all references to applicable law and Minnesota Statutes are to those in force on the date of my death shall incorporate any amendments and successor provisions. References to a particular section of the Internal Revenue Code shall incorporate any amendments and successor provisions.

6.2.2 Written Lists and Tangible Personal Property. To the extent I may have written more than one list disposing of tangible personal property, the most recent written list shall control if there are such inconsistent dispositions. If no such list is found by the later of (1) 60 days after the date of my death or (2) the date on which this will is admitted to probate, any dispositions made by such a list shall abate to the extent that such property has been distributed by my personal representative.

6.2.3 Writing. The requirement that a person act in "writing" requires a dated written document signed by such person.

6.2 Intentional Omission. I have intentionally limited gifts to my descendants to those provided in this will.
