1. Charter Amendment Request

a. Schools for Advanced Studies--Northwest Arkansas

Superintendent DeAnna Rowe and CEO/School Management Representative Dr. David Hubalik presented, via Zoom, a request to amend the charter by transitioning from an Arizona-based corporate board to a local Arkansas governing board.

2. Charter School Applications

a. Sheridan Jacket Academy

Mr. Andy Mayberry (Director of Communications) and Superintendent Chad Pitts along with several other Sheridan School District staff representatives presented an application for a district conversion charter to establish Jacket Academy within the Sheridan School District.

Following discussion and questions from CAP members, a motion was made to approve the application and issue a five-year charter contract.

3. Renewal of Existing Charters

a. Arkansas Virtual Academy

Executive Director Amy Johnson presented a request for the renewal of the contract for Arkansas Virtual Academy schools.

Following discussion and questions from CAP members, a motion was made to approve a five-year renewal for Arkansas Virtual Academy with the following conditions:

- Participation in quarterly Charter School Unit check-ins to monitor implementation and progress; and
- Administration of the ATLAS Interim Assessment to support consistent data analysis and timely accountability reporting.

b. Graduate Arkansas

c. Imboden Area Charter Schools

Superintendent Scott James presented the renewal request for Imboden Area Charter Schools.

- Issuance of a Notice of Performance Deficiency;
- Extension of the charter on a probationary or conditional basis with monthly monitoring and targeted support by the Charter School Unit and ASPRC; and
- A formal renewal hearing before the Charter Authorizing Panel in January 2027 to make a final determination regarding renewal.

4. Review and Consideration of School Improvement Plans

a. Institute for the Creative Arts

Representatives from the Institute for the Creative Arts did not attend the meeting.

- Approve issuance of a Notice of Performance Deficiency;
- Place the school on the August 2026 CAP agenda with the expectation that school leadership attend; and
- Direct the Charter School Unit to document the school's lack of engagement, refusal to engage, or failure to meaningfully participate in the improvement process as part of the record supporting the notice and August review.
