

COMMUNITY/AGENCY RELATIONS GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Nye County School District Board of Trustees is committed to open, two-way communication between citizens and schools; to providing the public with timely, accurate and complete information about their schools; and to supporting school/community partnerships to enhance the quality of education for students.

Trustees and staff share responsibility for communicating and interpreting district policies, programs, goals, and direction to the community. Trustees and staff shall strive to develop cooperative school district-community relations and to achieve mutual understanding and respect that are essential to the success of any public entity.

The Board encourages a district communications/community relations program that:

- A. Enhances communication, understanding, trust and mutual support between the district and the people it serves;
- B. Improves public participation, especially among parents, in school activities and programs, including program design and decision-making;
- C. Strengthens relationships and interactions among staff, citizens, parents and students; and
- D. Promotes understanding and cooperation between the schools and community groups, including neighborhoods; religious, fraternal and service organizations; labor; the media; business and industrial units; councils and political organizations; and other governmental agencies.
