STUDENT FUND - RAISING ACTIVITIES

Fundraising activities by students on school premises or elsewhere as representatives of the school will be permitted only when connected with specific school activities approved by the Governing Board.

Participation in contests or fundraising activities shall be governed by the following criteria:

- The aim of the activity shall benefit youth in educational, civic, social, and ethical development.
- The activity shall not interrupt the regularly planned instruction.
- Students shall not make door-to-door solicitations.
- Students shall not use a personal device to transmit personally identifying information of themselves and others to third party vendors in school-sponsored electronic fundraising activities.
- ~~Each recognized student group may raise up to fifty dollars (\$50) per student member per year up to a maximum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per organization per year with the approval of the building principal. Fundraising beyond this amount must receive prior approval of the Governing Board.~~
- **All fundraising activities conducted by recognized student groups must receive prior approval from the Governing Board.**

A portion of the proceeds of all fundraising activities shall be deposited in the Student Activity Fund, and funds from such activities shall be used only as specified in the Uniform System of Financial Records.
