Summer Programs

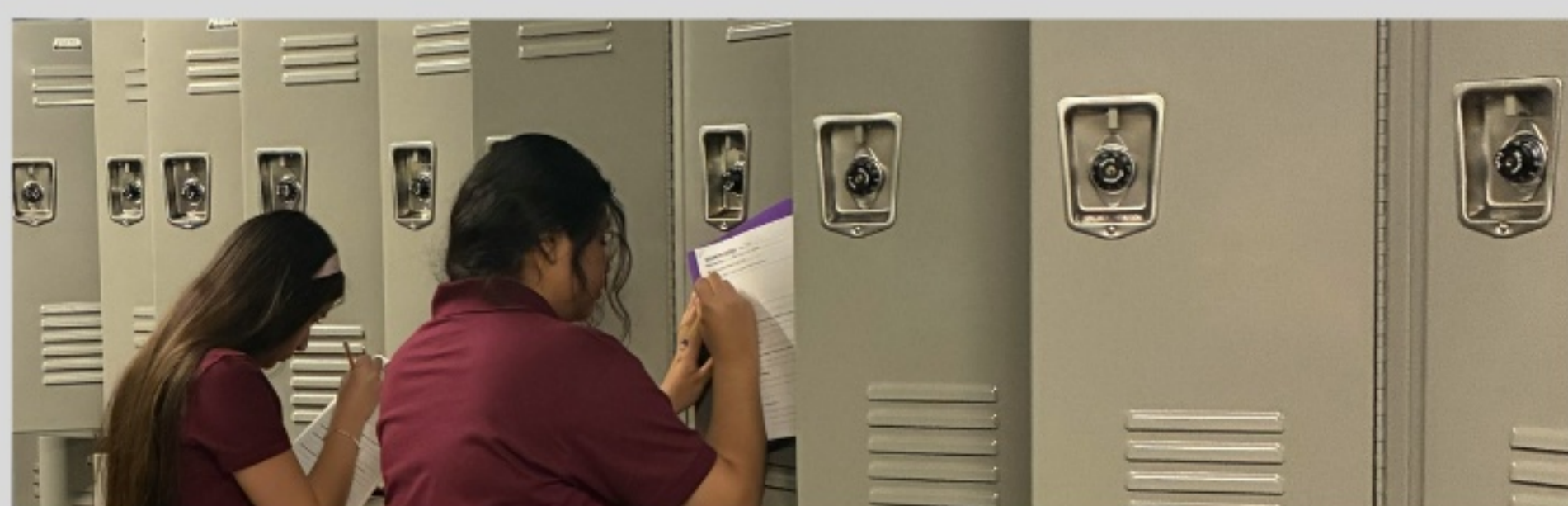
