

## **JTHS Safety & Security Report**

Joliet Township High School believes in a proactive approach to safety & security. By providing an environment conducive for all students, staff, and guests to learn, teach, and network allows every student to maximize their potential by positively impacting our community and thrive in a global society.

### **Staffing:**

JTHS currently employs the following Security staff.

- ✓ JT Central Team Consists of 23 Security Members & 1 Supervisor responsible for covering the Central, Pathways, & Transition campuses.
- ✓ JT West Team is made up of 19 Security members & 1 Supervisor.
- ✓ The Admin. Center Security is now a floating team member and will cover the Admin. Center and campuses as needed.
- ✓ Additionally, 5 café monitors, Instructional Paraprofessionals & Substitute Security to fill in when needed for vacancies and events.
- ✓ Joliet Police Dept. provides the district with 3 Detectives as our SROs (School Resource Officers) 1 at each main campus & and additional who floats between the buildings to assist with case load & fill-in.

### **Equipment:**

The Security Team works with, operates and maintains various types of equipment daily.

- ✓ 5 Security Vehicles
  - 2-Trucks (both campuses have new Security Trucks as of this month)
  - 2-Kubotas (1 at each campus purchased in 2025)
  - 1-Golf Cart (at Central for travel to Pathways & Transition Center.)
- ✓ 10 Evolv Weapon Detection Systems.
- ✓ 20 Handheld Scanners (for hall monitoring)
- ✓ Two-way Radios
- ✓ Raptor Access Control System
- ✓ Avigilon Camera System (772 Camera views)
- ✓ Monitored Door Access Control & Alert Contacts
- ✓ 35 AED Units (with NARCAN & STB Kits)

### **Training:**

Security Staff continue to receive training on various topics to assist them in their day-to-day operations.

- ✓ GCN Training (individual computer-based instruction and covers a variety of topics).
- ✓ CPR/AED, STB, NARCAN (certifications will be renewed next year)
- ✓ Training in bullying, gangs & drug activity.
- ✓ De-escalation techniques through Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) Training.
- ✓ Implicit Bias Training
- ✓ We also send team members to attend Culturally Responsive Cohort each year.
- ✓ Responding to Bomb Threats, Fire Alarms, & Active Incidents
- ✓ Disengaging physical altercations
