## **Recommendation**

## **Background Information**

In October of 2025 the Lyon County School Board of Trustees approved Policy IKD. This policy allows the middle and high schools in Lyon County School District to award elective credit for students that participate in outdoor activities as outlined in AB 501, passed in the 83<sup>rd</sup> Session of the Nevada State Legislature. When this policy was passed, it was requested that the Board receive an update in June, notifying them how many credits were awarded during the school year for students participating in Outdoor Activities.

As of June 12<sup>th</sup>, and the completion of the 2025-2026 school year no credits were awarded to students in the Lyon County School District for Outdoor Education.
