Agenda Item: Consider Approval of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement Between Terrell ISD and the University of Texas at Austin

Summary:

Administration recommends approval of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Terrell ISD and the University of Texas at Austin to participate in the Texas Regional Security Operations Center (RSOC) program. The RSOC is a state-funded cybersecurity initiative that provides 24/7 security monitoring, threat detection, incident notification, reporting, cybersecurity expertise, and educational resources to strengthen the district's cybersecurity posture and better protect district systems and data from evolving cyber threats.

There is **no cost** to Terrell ISD to participate in the program, as all services are funded through the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR). The agreement has an initial one-year term with automatic annual renewals unless terminated by either party with 60 days' notice. Administration recommends approval of this agreement to provide the district with enterprise-level cybersecurity monitoring and incident response services at no additional cost to the district.
