

**2.11 APPROVAL OF EXTENSION OF CONTRACT WITH FOREST SECURITY, INC.**

**A. SUBJECT**

This item is included on the agenda so the Board can approve the extension of contracts with Forest Security, Inc.

**B. INFORMATION**

In June 2019, the Board approved contracts with Forest Security for all aspects of security monitoring in the district including access control, strategically placed closed circuit TV cameras, and other devices to ensure the safety and security of students and staff. This contract is due to expire in June 2026 with auto renewal for an additional seven years.

Given the advances in technology, administration renegotiated the contract to be renewed for an additional two years with a 3% increase in the first year only. This allows District administrators to review all options for security in the district and bring an updated proposal forward in the future.

**C. RECOMMENDATION**

The Superintendent recommends extending the contract with Forest Security for an additional two years with a 3% increase in the first year.






