Guiding Outcome: Reciprocal Family & Community Partnerships

Summary: Communities in Schools (CIS) of North Texas submitted and secured a federal grant through Title IV, Part B (21st Century Community Learning Centers) to facilitate after school programming that includes academic tutorials, enrichment, engaging activities and meals for students.

Background Information/  
Previous Board Action: Students attending targeted campuses with high numbers of economically disadvantaged learners will receive high quality after school programs to support student achievement. Campuses, through the Campus Needs Assessment and Campus Improvement Plan processes, have identified needs to support students and families in the areas of academic achievement, behavior management, and accessing resources. Campus administrators work with CIS staff to identify students who would benefit from after school academic support. Annual renewal of the MOU with CIS has been approved by the Denton ISD School Board for many years.
