

**SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS**

The Nye County School District Board of Trustees encourages parents and other members of the community to volunteer their time for purposes that benefit our students.

The administrative staff will supervise all work performed by volunteers. Volunteers who perform indirectly supervised work will need to complete a satisfactory background check prior to working on their own.

The school district recognizes that parents play an integral role in assisting their children to learn, promotes a safe and open atmosphere for parents to visit the school, and actively solicits parent and family support for school programs. Because of this, the school district actively encourages parents to volunteer in their students' classrooms and at school programs. Parent volunteers must work under the direct supervision of a staff member or administrator. The District requires no formal background check for a parent working under the direct supervision of the teacher or administrator (**exceptions exist**). The District will check the names of all parent volunteers against the ~~sex offender list in the Nye County Sheriff's office~~ **Nevada Sex Offender Registry** to ensure student safety.

Other community members who wish to volunteer must complete a formal background check.

The administration must control all services provided by volunteers. The administration may not use volunteers to take the place of licensed educators. Volunteers, under the supervision of licensed educators, may assist as permitted by state law and school district regulation.

**All volunteers must comply with school district policy, specifically those related to anti-harassment, workplace violence and code of conduct.**
