

**COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT SYSTEM**

The demonstration of accountability and the use of information as decision-making tools require the systematic gathering, processing and analysis of data. The assessment system in the Nye County School District will provide data to help teachers improve student learning, create instructional focus, help schools develop performance profiles and help the District evaluate its schools and programs. The assessment system will provide appropriate/accurate data to parents, the Nye County School District Board of Trustees and community, and will guide decisions to improve student learning in the District.

The District assessment plan components will be: State mandated tests, classroom assessment and District assessment (including ~~K-4-2~~ **K-12** assessment).

The Superintendent/designee is authorized to establish and maintain a systematic plan for assessment and evaluation of students to ensure that the following elements are in place:

1. Comprehensive assessment of student achievement given in the core academic areas annually; and
2. Progress on student achievement reported in an annual report card to be presented to the Board of Trustees as specified by State statute.

Results of assessment will be evaluated, and curriculum will be modified as necessary.
