RELEASE OF STUDENTS DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

~~Children~~ **Students** are not to be released from school at the request of any person other than the parent(s) or **legal** guardian(s) with whom they are living, as shown on the enrollment card. The sole exception to this is the release of ~~children~~ **students** to peace officers, **DCFS** or under a court order.

“School Day” defined:

From the time a student boards the school bus, or arrives at school, until they exit the school bus; or if student is at school at a time after the normal closing of the school office for educational purposes; or until the end of a school sponsored event.
