The Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD), Right to Farm Program, reviewed your application packet submitted for review as part of your request for conformance with the Generally Accepted Agricultural and Management Practices for Site Selection and Odor Control for New and Expanding Livestock Facilities (Site Selection GAAMPs).
