Enjoy dinner and some free time to relax and swim at Karibea hotel.

### Thursday, February 13, 2020—Day 2

#### Guided Cultural Tour of Northern Martinique

##### Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Enjoy breakfast at your accommodations before embarking on a guided tour of the Northern part of the island of Martinique. You will depart from your hotel via bus with stops along the way to include sites such as: Sacre Coeur de Balata, a beautiful church and exact replica of Paris' own Sacred Heart Basilica in its Montmartre district; the Balata Botanical Garden, whose beauty continually inspires its visitors; cut through the tropical rainforest and the village of Morne Rouge. Arrive in Saint-Pierre, a city of art and history, the Little Pompeii of the Caribbean! This former capital of Martinique was entirely destroyed by the 1902 eruption of Mount Pelee and is now renowned for its ruins. Lunch will be provided at a local restaurant en route to the volcano. The tour will continue on to the Atlantic coast, destination to be determined, with a stop in Tilo for leisure time and souvenir shopping.

### Friday, February 14, 2020—Day 3

#### Guided Cultural Tour of Southern Martinique

##### Visit Josephine's Bathtub

##### Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Have breakfast at your hotel, then depart for Southern Martinique. Head to François Marina, where you will board a boat and travel up to the islets where you will be served a refreshing drink. Swim in Josephine's Bathtub, where a unique sandbar lies in the middle of the ocean. You're able to stand and enjoy the surrounding mountain views. Then sail to Robert Island, famous for its iguanas. Lunch and fun games on the boat. Return to your hotel in the evening for dinner and overnight accommodations.

### Saturday, February 15, 2020—Day 4

#### Kayaking at Cap Chevalier Lagoon

##### Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, then depart from your hotel to Sainte Anne for a day of kayaking. Discover the Cap Chevalier lagoon, followed by a barbecue lunch on the beach! Take some time to shop and see local sites, then return to your hotel.

### Sunday, February 16, 2020—Day 5

#### Full Day Tour of Martinique's Produce Industries

**Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

After breakfast at your hotel, depart for the town of Gros-Morne, where you will dive deep into Martinique’s local industries by visiting the Denel factory, which produces jams and juices from local fruits, the Saint-Etienne garden. Learn how local fruits are transformed into different products—stroll through a pineapple orchard and see how honey is produced. Finish with a tasting of exotic juices, jams, and condiments. Visit their shop, where you can buy your favorite wares. Stop by a local farm in the Martinique countryside—be welcomed by the local farmer and learn how his harvest is produced. Taste some of the fruit and then depart for a picnic lunch and swim in the nearby river. Visit the impressive botanical garden, which features statues made by a local artist. At the conclusion of your tour, return to your hotel, pack for tomorrow’s departure and relax.

**Monday, February 17, 2020—Day 6**

**Depart**

**Meals: Breakfast, subject to flight schedule**

After breakfast or breakfast box to go, transfer to a major local airport for your return flight. It is important to arrive at least three hours before your international flight is scheduled to depart. On Guadeloupe, we will arrange a hike or a cultural activity during the layover time.
