

CLASS SIZE

It is the intent of the Board of Education, in so far as financial resources and facilities allow, to provide class sizes for an individual teacher that do not exceed the ranges listed below:

Grade Level Ranges:

Kindergarten	17 – 25
Grade 1	17 – 26
Grades 2-3	18 – 27
Grades 4-5	20 – 29
Grades 6-8	24 – 34 (average 30 based on 6 teaching periods) PE = 200

Administrative discussion occurs at the high and low end of the range regarding the feasibility of adding or reducing the number of sections; the need for providing instructional and/or clerical support/modification/adaptation to the standard program; and consideration of alternative organizational models for delivery of instruction. The administration may also utilize an instructional aide to assist in balancing class sections.

Student grouping, mainstreaming, inclusion, gifted and similar factors may be taken into account when balancing class sizes. It is recognized that student enrollments shift during the year, which may change that balance.

The above procedures will be implemented, unless in the judgment of the Superintendent, the particular circumstances are not practical. The Superintendent will recommend to the Board of Education the most feasible means of addressing the situation and will implement voluntary and involuntary transfer of students as called for by Policy 7:30 and detailed in Regulation 7:30-R.
