 - 6.1. Before & After School Care RFP
S. Strasser provided a timeline outlining information leading up to the decision to explore all options and alternatives for before and after school care. The committee re-evaluated the options available for staffing in before and after school care programs. The committee weighed the pros and cons of each option. The exploratory RFP process closes Friday, April 17th. At that time RCS staff will use a rubric to evaluate each of the proposals submitted. Proposals will also be measured up against the current AM Action & Action 330 programs. Based on timelines for high level decisions like this, the RCS Department is planning to operate AM Action and Action 330 for the 2026-2027 school year with an update in the payroll reporting process.
