- The Winter Sports season has concluded for the 2025-26 school year and all Spring Sports are now practicing with contests on the horizon!

### Athletics Updates

#### **Hockey**

- The Boys Northern Lakes Lightning season ended their season by qualifying for the MSHSL State A Championships where they fell in Consolation Semi-Finals. They lost in the QuarterFinals to eventual State Champion Warroad. They qualified for the State Tournament in a thrilling 3-2 OVERTIME victory in the Section 6A Championship over Sartell. Their overall record on the season ended up at 17-12-1.

#### **Boys Basketball**

- The Ranger Boys finished 11-16 on the season and lost in the Section 7AA 1st Round against Pillager. Jack Kovatovich and Ethan Millsop were named to the All-Conference team for the Great River Conference with Andrew Taylor as Honorable Mention.

#### **Girls Basketball**

- The Lady Rangers finished their season in a defeat against Pequot Lakes in the Section 7AA Semi-Finals. They finished with a 22-6 overall record and won the Great River Conference Championship for the second consecutive year. Tori Oehrlein became the fastest player in Minnesota History to eclipse 5000 points, was named All-State for the fourth consecutive season and is a finalist for the Minnesota Ms. Basketball award. Tori was named the Great River Conference MVP and to the All-Conference team along with Sammie Hachey and Lucy Lewandowski with Veronica Millsop receiving Honorable Mention.

#### **Wrestling**

- Multiple wrestlers finished on the Podium at the Section 7A individual Championships. Weston McKay finished 3rd at 145 lbs, John Frahm was 4th at 285 lbs, Liam Fitzpatrick placed 4th at 139 lbs, Ezra Jacobson finished 5th at 121 lbs and Deacon Larson also was 5th at 172 lbs. They won their 1st Round Matchup in the Section 7A Team Tournament 54-23 over Blackduck/Cass Lake-Bena before falling to the eventual Class A State Champions Staples-Motley in the QuarterFinals.
