Re: Approval All Points of Texas to move furniture and salvage old furniture and equipment at Coppell Middle School North, CTE Center at CHS, Lakeside Elementary, and New Tech High @ Coppell

As part of the 2023 bond election (Proposition A), as campuses receive interior refreshes or additions and renovations, the campus will also receive new furniture. This necessitates the need to move all furniture and teachers' supplies and boxes either into storage or to salvage the old furniture and equipment. Then, after the construction is completed at the end of summer, the stored furniture and teacher boxes and equipment must be moved back into their respective classrooms. This includes the construction at Lakeside Elementary and moving all their furniture and equipment to the former New Tech building, as well as, either storing or salvaging all the furniture, equipment, and teacher boxes for the refresh at CMS North. Additionally, the furniture and equipment moves for the CTE additions and the New Tech renovated spaces at Coppell High School require moves, storage, and placement back into classrooms at the end of the summer break. In summary, there is a great deal of moving and salvaging to take place at all four of these locations.

We have used the moving company, All Points of Texas, to do this same turn-key work over the last two summers with great success. The proposal from All Points of Texas was procured in accordance with Texas Education Code §44.031 through the district's membership with TASB Buyboard – All Points of Texas Contract 738-24.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve the hiring of All Points of Texas to move boxes and furniture, and salvage old furniture and equipment as it relates to the construction at Lakeside Elementary, the Coppell High School CTE center, the former New Tech High @ Coppell building, and the newly renovated New Tech High @ Coppell spaces at a total cost of \$195,245.24.
