Subject: EAHS Stadium Scoreboard RFP Results

The Issue:

EAHS Stadium Scoreboard was installed in 2017. The location of installation has led to damage which cannot be sustainably repaired. We have the current unit running enough to display the most basic information about the current game in progress.

Justification:

A modern scoreboard in an alternative location will provide the school with several opportunities that cannot be done with the current scoreboard and location.

- Video Engagement of the fans
- Digital Ads
- Sponsored Segments
- Potential of student learning lab

Board Policy and Past Practices:

Pursuant to Board Policy 4:60, Supplies, materials, or work involving an expenditure in excess of \$25,000 must comply with the State law bidding procedure, 105 ILCS 5/10-20.21, unless specifically exempted including (vii) purchase and contracts for the use, purchase, delivery, movement, or installation of data processing equipment, software, or services and telecommunications and interconnect equipment, software and services.

Strategic Plan:

This recommendation supports Strategic Goal #2, Operational Excellence that states the following: *East Aurora School District 131 will align and utilize systems and resources that promote operational excellence, efficiency, and fiscal accountability.*

Financial Impact:

The project would be co-funded out of district funds and a donation from the Aurora East Educational Foundation (AEEF). The total project is \$219,160

District Funds: \$94,160

AEEF Donation: \$125,000

Supporting Data:

The RPF for the EAHS Stadium Scoreboard project was issued on March 2nd, 2026, with a walkthrough held on March 9th. Proposals were due on March 27th, 2026. Four (4) vendors who attended the Triple I conference were invited to attend. Of the four (4) invited, three (3) vendors attended the walkthrough; two (2) proposals were received. The proposal from Digital Scoreboards was received after the due date on March 30th, 2026

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board of Education move forward with Correct Digital Display's proposal in the amount of \$219,160.
