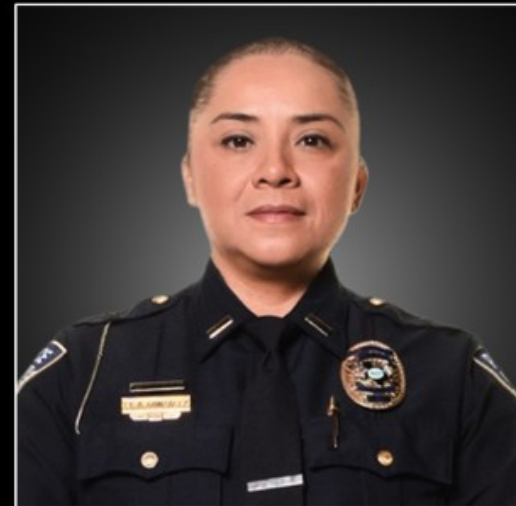

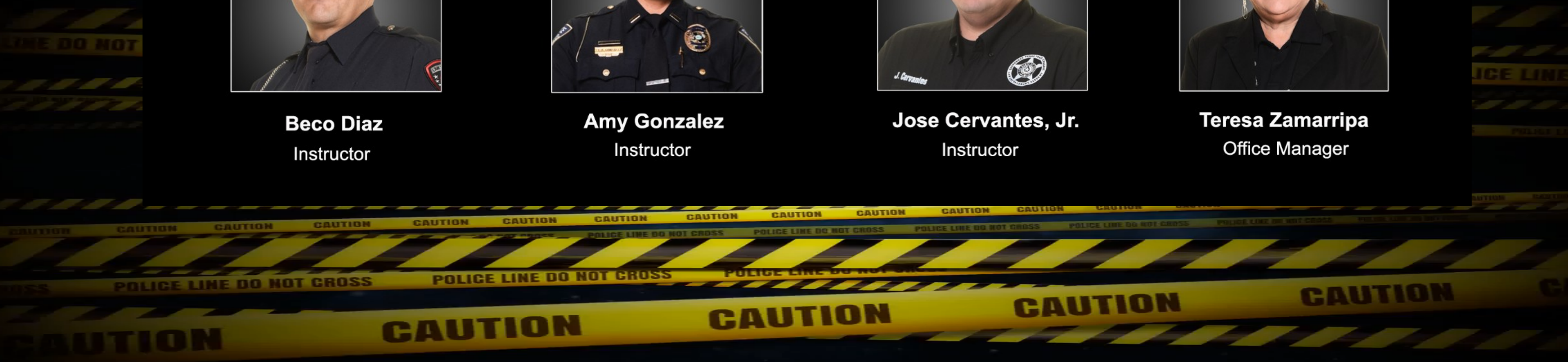

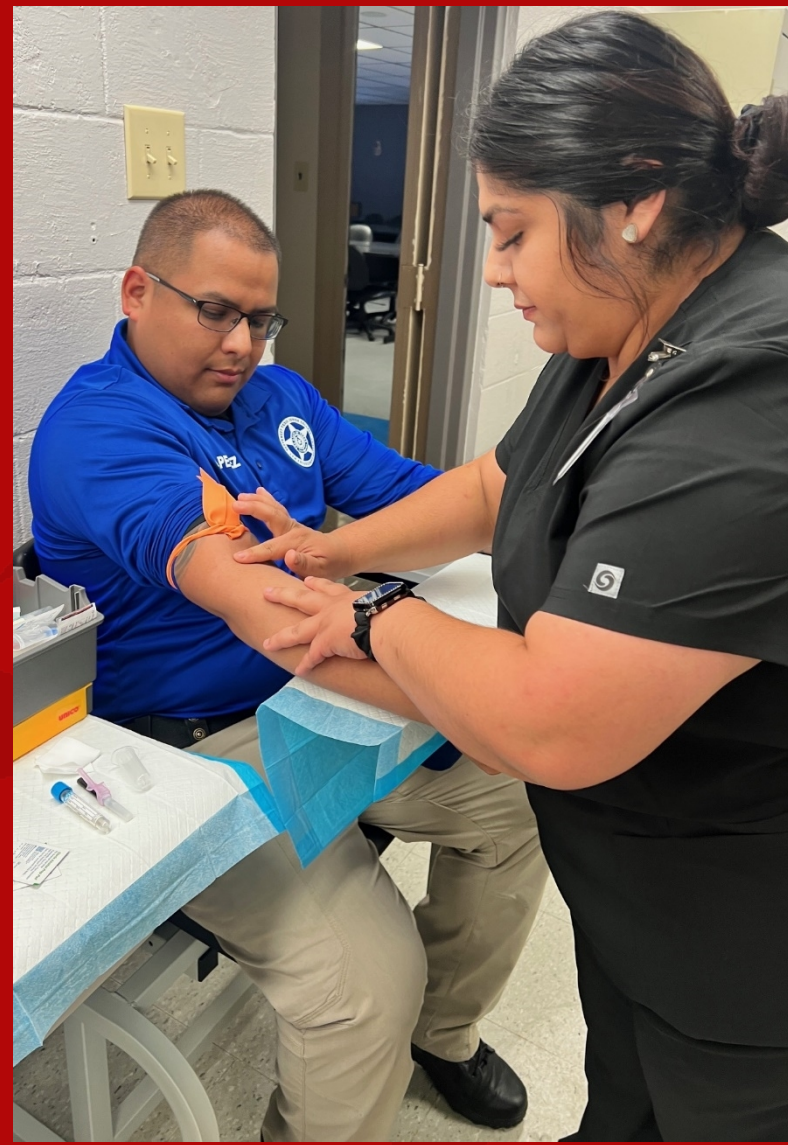
Strategic Plan Initiative
