## Architectural Services

- Held two design meetings with DKA to review several early renditions of what the TTC building could look like, including overall layout, program placement, building flow, and exterior concepts.
- Continued coordination with DKA on key design questions, including aviation mechanics layout, restaurant capacity, testing center space, storage needs, site circulation, and future flex-space opportunities.

## Additional Items

- Continued review of project insurance and construction management considerations with CLIC/Gallagher.
- Reviewed sample naming-rights/sponsorship materials from Mahomet-Seymour as a possible reference for the TTC sponsorship framework.
- Continued exploration of possible TTC testing center space for student certification exams, including Pearson VUE-style testing needs.
