Goal Update

By June 2027, students in grades 9-12 will demonstrate improved student academic achievement and growth as evidenced below. Growth will be monitored at three assessment points per year and addressed through targeted interventions.

- **Graduation Rate:** At or above 90%, and subgroup graduation rates will be within 5 percentage points of the overall rate. [100% of our current students graduated](#)
- **Progress Learning Benchmarks (Grades 9–10):** At least 80% of students will meet or exceed content grade/level benchmarks.
- **ACT (Grade 11):** Average score will meet or exceed the 2026 Illinois state average.

By June 2027, students in grades 5–8 will demonstrate improved student academic achievement and growth as evidenced below. Growth will be monitored at three assessment points per year and addressed through targeted interventions.

Assessment Target -MAP Growth: At least 80% of students will meet or exceed their projected growth target.

- **Math: 86% of students of all students**
 - Subgroups:
 - Special Education: 78% of students
 - Low Income: 88% of students
- **Reading: 82% of students of all students!**
 - Subgroups:
 - Special Education: 51%
 - Low Income: 43%

By June 2027, students in grades 1-4 will demonstrate improved student academic achievement and growth as evidenced below. Growth will be monitored at three assessment points per year and addressed through targeted interventions.

Assessment Target -MAP Growth: At least 80% of students will meet or exceed their projected growth target.

- **Math: 91% of students of all students**
 - Subgroups:
 - Special Education: 78% of students
 - Low Income: 87% of students
- **Reading: 88% of students of all students!**
 - Subgroups:
 - Special Education: 72% of students
 - Low Income: 95% of students
