Local school systems are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education (SBOE) and the commissioner, in accordance with Texas Education Code (TEC) 31.1011, that students have access to instructional materials that cover all Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for required subjects, excluding physical education. As part of this process, the 2026–27 Certification Prework Form—a fillable and printable PDF designed to mirror the online survey—is completed offline to guide accurate submission and then presented to the board of trustees for ratification and signatures. Additionally, the certification survey requires districts to affirm compliance with protections against student access to obscene or harmful content, including adherence to the Children’s Internet Protection Act, Section 28.0022, Section 43.22 of the Penal Code, and any other applicable laws or regulations safeguarding students.
