

## May 2026 Transportation Report

1. This Summer will be transporting 2 students to out of district schools to extend school year services. One student to Hammitt and one student to High Roads Peoria for their extended school year needs provided through their IEP.
2. This summer all the drivers will need to take their yearly refresher course to maintain their license.
3. Our 2 new buses have been delivered. Starting May 18 all regular routes will have A/C. We will continue to look for a 10 passenger Van this Summer to replace one of our other vans. We also have another transportation Van over 100,000 miles that I will look to replace this Summer.
4. We were able to facilitate 62 field trips this school year. We were able to facilitate all of these. This is up 40% from last school year. We were full staff all year and it made those easier to accommodate.
5. This school year, to date, we have utilized 10 buses and 2 vans to drive a total of 177,397 miles, as of May 4th. These miles are for transporting students to and from Illini Central, 1 student to Central Elementary in Lincoln, Lincoln High School for LTEC (11), High Roads Peoria (1), Menta in Havana (2), High Roads in Bloomington (2), and Hammitt in Bloomington (4). The average number of students transported per day is 249 (excluding LTEC and after school shuttle).
6. We continue to use the driver's Ipad to submit timesheets, track mileage, bus rider attendance and we implemented an electronic conduct report to handle discipline quicker. We continue to be more efficient and up to date in real time.
7. We have priced cloud based camera systems for the buses in the past. I would like to explore that as an option again. The last quote I have is from Oct. 2025 for \$52,630. Currently that process is our least efficient. Myself or Lloyd have to manually go to the bus and get the camera cartridge, then copy the footage I need for administration, and then try to get the cartridge back to that bus before its next trip. The cloud based system would eliminate that as well as give principals access to the footage right away.
8. All the buses are current on their state inspections and maintenance.
