

INDEPENDENT STUDY PROGRAMS

In addition to opportunities to earn credits in the school classroom setting and through approved distance education programs, the Nye County School District allows students to earn high school credits through District-approved independent correspondence courses.

Independent study is allowed for students who are unable to attend a regular building program or need to supplement their current education program. The program is also permitted as an option to students who have been excluded from the District's regular program. All students enrolling in independent study will follow program guidelines.

With the permission of the Superintendent/Designee, students may take approved independent study courses. A maximum of six credits may be earned through independent study or correspondence courses. Courses required for graduation will be taken according to the District's curriculum scope and sequence.
