**New Contract - Annual Renewal, No Cost to SPS**

- 1) **Big Brothers Big Sisters** Mentoring Service Agreement

SPS is re-establishing a partnership with Big Brothers Big Sisters (BBBS) through a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to provide school-based mentoring for students who would benefit from additional positive adult relationships. Through this program, trained and vetted community volunteers (“Bigs”) will meet with matched students (“Littles”) on campus during designated times to build supportive, consistent relationships. The program is designed to promote student well-being, improve school engagement, and strengthen academic and social outcomes. The MOU outlines responsibilities around student participation, parental consent, mentor screening and training, scheduling, and data privacy. This partnership aligns with SPS’s ongoing efforts to provide wraparound support and promote equity and student connection. This contract is valid from June 10, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**New Contract - Annual Renewal, No Cost to SPS**

- 2) **Horizon: Digitally** Supplemental Online AP Courses Agreement

Horizon has a contract with the State of Oklahoma to provide free online access to AP courses and teachers to instruct and grade work for these courses to meet the requirements of legislation. Thus, this MOU with Horizon will not cost the district any money or FTEs and will allow SHS to provide a variety of AP course offerings for students. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**New Contract - Annual Renewal, No Cost to SPS, ROI - Meets Graduation Requirements**

- 3) **Junior Achievement Finance Park** Financial Literacy Curriculum Agreement

This MOU provides Financial Literacy curriculum via Junior Achievement of Oklahoma. The vendor will provide student workbooks and ready-made 14 lessons that meet the PFL competencies. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**New Contract - Annual Renewal, No Cost to SPS**

- 4) **Northeastern State University** Student Teaching Affiliation Agreement

This agreement between NSU and Stillwater Public Schools concerns the placement of students enrolled in the programs served by the Teacher Education Program within Stillwater Public Schools to complete their required field / clinical experiences as part of their degree program. The students will be required to submit a cleared background check and complete all district-required training. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

The agreement with The University of Tulsa concerns the field clinical experiences for the Department of Communication Sciences & Disorders students within Stillwater Public Schools. ### **Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Activity Fund**

#### **1) ACT WorkKeys Hiring Assessment Services Agreement**

Stillwater Public Schools is committed to the professional development and ongoing certification of its support staff. Stillwater Public Schools is partnering with ACT WorkKeys to serve as a test administration site for potential teacher assistants who are seeking their paraprofessional certification. This partnership will allow Stillwater Public School staff to administer the WorkKeys assessment to potential and current staff so they do not have to seek other outside testing sites. The Stillwater Public Schools administration staff has completed training to be able to administer the WorkKeys assessment. No changes from last year. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Federal Fund**

2) **Advanced Therapy Solutions** Speech-Language Therapy Services

Advanced Therapy Solutions will perform speech/language therapy and/or evaluation services for special education students in the district. They will attend IEP team meetings and work on the development of speech/language goals and services. The evaluations will include eligibility report writing and other related services as requested. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

3) **Alpha Autism Therapy** Behavioral Therapy Services

Applied Behavioral Analysis Clinic, and this agreement will allow the clinic to provide behavioral support to their clients who are SPS students at no cost to the district. ABA clinics utilize research-based strategies to increase a student's ability to engage in socially appropriate behaviors with peers and staff members and increase opportunities for success in the school setting. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Federal Fund**

4) **Angela Brand, Thera-Brand Physical Therapy, LLC** Physical Therapy Services Agreement

Angela Brand/Thera-Brand Physical Therapy, LLC agrees to work with Stillwater Public Schools to provide physical therapy for designated students as requested by the terms of the agreement. The PT shall provide such physical therapy services as indicated by the Stillwater Public Schools student's Individualized Education Program or 504 Accommodation Plan. The services shall include, without limitation, providing physical therapy evaluations and treatment as deemed appropriate by PT and the Stillwater Public Schools Special Education Director, recording students' progress, preparing materials and assembling equipment used during treatment if necessary, participation in student-focused and program-focused meetings and completing paperwork as requested including Medicaid documentation forms. Said services will be provided at the rate of \$70.00 per hour up to 1400 hours. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Federal Fund**

5) **ARH Therapy Inc.** Occupational Therapy Services Agreement

ARH Therapy, Inc. agrees to make available to SPS the services of a certified occupational therapist (OTR). The OTR shall provide such occupational therapy services as indicated by the SPS student's IEP or 504 Accommodation Plan as established by the OTR. The OTR services shall include, without limitation, establishing a plan of care, recording the student's progress, preparing materials and assembling equipment used during treatment, participating in student-focused meetings and program-focused meetings, and completing paperwork as determined by SPS. Said services will be provided at the rate of \$85.00 per hour. No changes from the previous year. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

6) **Counseling and Behavior Specialists**, Counseling and Behavioral Therapy Services Agreement

CBSO provides Applied Behavioral Therapy for students in Stillwater and surrounding areas. This agreement will allow CBSO staff to visit classrooms in our schools to observe student clients. This observation will allow collaboration between the IEP team and CBSO to ensure the most appropriate behavioral services are implemented in the school setting. CBSO will not bill the district for any observation or collaboration entailed within this agreement. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS, ROI - The partnership between SPS and CREOKS provides students with access to licensed behavioral health professionals at no cost to the district. CREOKS clinicians offer trauma-informed therapy, crisis intervention, case management, and family support that reduce absenteeism, behavioral incidents, and time lost to untreated mental health needs. For the first time in district history (2024–25 school year), we are systematically tracking visits and service delivery from our mental health partners. While these agencies provide a critical service, they also bill insurance/Medicaid for services**

**rendered—making it essential that we hold them accountable for the work happening on our campuses. This new level of oversight allows us to ensure quality, share data, and demonstrate the real-time impact of these partnerships for students, families, and schools.**

**7) CREOKS Health Services Counseling Services Agreement**

CREOKS is a key partner in delivering school-based mental health services. This ongoing collaboration supports the district's commitment to student wellness by providing on-site counseling, crisis intervention, case management, and family support services. The continued partnership helps ensure that students have timely access to licensed mental health professionals during the school day, reducing barriers to care and supporting academic and emotional success. The updated MOU reflects current roles, expectations, and compliance with all district policies, legal requirements, and confidentiality standards. SPS recommends approval of this renewed agreement to maintain and strengthen this vital support system for students and families. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund**

**8) Danielle Torres Psychology Services Agreement**

Danielle Torres, a Nationally Board-Certified School Psychologist, will work with SPS to provide evaluation services for students. These evaluations will be used to determine the need for special education and related services for students. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund**

**9) Evaluation Works, LLC Psychology Services Agreement**

Evaluation Works, LLC provides psychological evaluations, reports, and other related services for the purpose of special education services. Said services will be provided at the agreed-upon rate. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund**

**10) Golden Oaks Early Childhood Partnership Agreement**

Golden Oaks, LLC, agrees to partner with Stillwater Public Schools for the development of an "intergenerational" early childhood educational program for four-year-old children. Golden Oak's elderly residents are given the opportunity to interact with and participate in limited aspects of the program as classroom volunteers. Golden Oaks will provide the classroom space for the program. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS, ROI - GRAND Mental Health delivers Tier 3 behavioral health services to SPS students - focusing on those with the most significant mental health and safety needs. Through embedded therapists and mobile crisis response, GRAND reduces ER visits, stabilizes students on campus, and ensures access to urgent, ongoing care. GRAND also provides wraparound support teams at several school sites, including school-based case managers, therapists, and family navigators. These teams have been instrumental in maintaining support for high-need students - especially important as recent state-level budget cuts have reduced the number of school counselors. SPS is actively working with GRAND to expand and strengthen this model to help fill those critical service gaps. As of the 24–25 school year, SPS began formally tracking all GRAND Mental Health services provided within our schools. This is a major step forward in transparency and accountability. While GRAND bills Medicaid for services rendered, SPS now ensures that time spent in our buildings is aligned with student needs and documented outcomes. This new structure enables us to analyze visit frequency, identify gaps, and ensure that our schools are benefiting from every hour of support delivered.**

**11) GRAND Mental Health Center Counseling Services Agreement**

GRAND Mental Health is a key partner in delivering school-based mental health services. This ongoing collaboration supports the district's commitment to student wellness by providing on-site counseling, crisis intervention, case management, and family support services. The continued partnership helps ensure that students have timely access to licensed mental health professionals during the school day, reducing barriers to care and supporting academic and emotional success. SPS recommends approval of this

renewed agreement to maintain and strengthen this vital support system for students and families. The updated MOU reflects current roles, expectations, and compliance with all district policies, legal requirements, and confidentiality standards. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Year 1 of 3, Bond Fund**

**12) Instructure, Inc. Learning Management System Agreement**

Instructure provides our secondary students learning management system (LMS), Canvas. Canvas is a comprehensive Learning Management System (LMS) that supports teaching and learning in both traditional and digital classrooms. It serves as a central hub where educators can organize and deliver instructional content, manage assignments and assessments, communicate with students and families, and monitor student progress. Canvas enhances instructional consistency across grade levels and supports personalized learning by integrating with tools like Google Workspace, Microsoft Office, and other educational applications. Its user-friendly design and robust analytics also provide administrators with valuable insights into student engagement and academic performance. Widely adopted in K–12 and higher education, Canvas helps districts ensure equitable access to learning resources and supports high-quality instruction aligned with educational goals. The level of purchase support was decreased, and we are transitioning to a 3-year contract with an opt-out option. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

**13) Meridian Technology Center Academic Credit Options Agreement**

The Memorandum of Understanding with Meridian Technology Center concerns the academic credit options provided at Meridian for Stillwater Public Schools' students. The Oklahoma State Department of Education requires documentation of the local school board's approval for mathematics and science courses to be counted toward the local district's graduation requirements. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund**

**14) Meridian Technology Center Gateway to Technology Program Agreement**

Stillwater Public Schools will provide the Stillwater Middle School Gateway to Technology Program, and Meridian Technology Center will provide supplemental funding for the program in the sum of \$50,000.00. The funding award is for classroom and/or lab costs of the program. The program for 6th - 8th grade students is designed to actively engage learners in hands-on projects and career exploration in an effort to increase student interest in viable careers and continued education and training. This grant will continue on an annual basis as long as adequate funding is available and program evaluations continue to provide positive indicators for continued support. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Federal Fund**

**15) Motor Mouth Therapy Occupational Therapy Services Agreement**

Motor Mouth Therapy will provide Occupational Therapy services for students at assigned buildings during the 25-26 school year. These services are determined by the IEP team and mandated by law once decided upon. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Federal Fund**

**16) MPower Vocational Services Agreement**

MPower will provide vocational services for IEP students in the Pathfinder program. These students focus on functional skills. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund, ROI - Allows for student and family supports to ensure all students have the supports they need to be academically successful.**

**17) Oklahoma Human Services School-Based Services Agreement**

OKDHS will provide School-Based Specialists to be placed within Stillwater Public Schools. Through the partnership, a School-Based Specialist (SBS) is placed within the district with the dedicated purpose of providing a human service connection and support to the children and families served by the school, as well as the school's teachers and administrators. SPS will provide office space and pay 50% of the salary, benefits, and administrative costs. This contract will be officially signed through a secure signature request sent to the President of the Stillwater Public School Board of Education. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund**

18) **Oklahoma State University Communications Sciences** Speech Language Services Agreement  
OSU Communications Sciences will provide speech-language services for the academic school year in accordance with the University calendar. They will provide eligibility and re-evaluations as needed, therapy services, and prepare Special Education paperwork. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

19) **Oklahoma State University Department of English** Student Teaching Affiliation Agreement  
This agreement between OSU and Stillwater Public Schools concerns the placement of students enrolled in the programs served by the Department of English within Stillwater Public Schools to complete their required field / clinical experiences as part of their degree program. The students will be required to submit a cleared background check and complete all district-required training. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

20) **Oklahoma State University Office of Educator Support** Student Teaching Affiliation Agreement  
This agreement between OSU and Stillwater Public Schools concerns the placement of students enrolled in the programs and departments served by the Office of Educator Support within Stillwater Public Schools to complete their required field / clinical experiences as part of their degree program. The students will be required to submit a cleared background check and complete all district-required training. The updated MOU reflects additional course placement requests. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS, ROI - Allows students to earn college credit while meeting high school graduation requirements.**

21) **Oklahoma State University Onsite Concurrent Programming** Concurrent Programming Agreement  
This agreement between OSU Concurrent Programming and Stillwater Public Schools allows for current Stillwater High School juniors and seniors to complete specific OSU courses concurrently onsite at SHS. All instructors will be OSU employees who meet or exceed HLC guidelines. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

22) **Oklahoma State University School of Allied Health and Recreation** Student Internship Affiliation Agreement  
This agreement between OSU's School of Allied Health and Stillwater Public School Athletics' Department concerns the placement of student athletic trainers and strength and conditioning coaching interns within Stillwater Public Schools. The interns will work with SPS' Athletics' Department to provide additional support to our athletic training and coaching staff. The student interns hosted by SPS will be required to submit a cleared background check and complete the required OSHA training set forth by SPS. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

23) **Oklahoma State University School of Psychology** Student Teaching Affiliation Agreement  
This agreement between OSU and Stillwater Public Schools concerns the placement of students enrolled in the programs served by the School of Psychology within Stillwater Public Schools to complete their required field / clinical experiences as part of their degree program. The students will be required to

submit a cleared background check and complete all district-required training. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

**24) Our Daily Bread Lincoln Marketplace Agreement**

SPS seeks to continue its partnership with Our Daily Bread Food and Resource Center through an MOU for the 2025–2026 school year. This collaboration supports the operation of the Lincoln Academy Marketplace, an on-campus food pantry housed at Lincoln Alternative Academy. The Marketplace provides essential food and resources to students in need, helping address food insecurity and supporting overall student well-being. The MOU outlines the responsibilities of both parties, ensures proper use and access to space, and formalizes procedures related to stocking, data reporting, volunteer support, and compliance with legal and safety requirements. No changes from the previous year. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

**25) Payne County Youth Services, Inc. Counseling Services Agreement**

SPS seeks to renew its existing MOU with Iowa Tribe Behavioral Health, a key partner in delivering school-based mental health services. This ongoing collaboration supports the district's commitment to student wellness by providing on-site counseling, crisis intervention, case management, and family support services. The continued partnership helps ensure that students have timely access to licensed mental health professionals during the school day, reducing barriers to care and supporting academic and emotional success. The updated MOU reflects current roles, expectations, and compliance with all district policies, legal requirements, and confidentiality standards. SPS recommends approval of this renewed agreement to maintain and strengthen this vital support system for students and families. No changes from the previous year. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Federal Fund**

**26) Shannan Frohock Consultant Services for Hearing Impaired Students Agreement**

Shannan Frohock agrees to work with Stillwater Public Schools to provide to Stillwater Public Schools such consulting services as requested during the term of this agreement pertaining to special education services for students categorized as Hearing Impaired. The consultant shall provide such consulting services as indicated by the Stillwater Public Schools students' Individualized Education Program or 504 Accommodation Plan. The services shall include, without limitation, review and study students' educational/confidential records, monitoring equipment, conducting student evaluations, preparing required Individualized Education Program documentation, completing forms and reports in connection with the development of Individualized Education Programs, participation in student-focused and program-focused meetings including Individualized Education Program meetings and other staff meetings and completing documentation forms. Said services will be provided at the rate of \$70.00 per hour. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund**

**27) Specialty Care Pediatrics Supplemental Staffing Agreement**

Specialty Care will provide a personal nurse at one of our elementary school sites for a special education student who has extensive medical needs. This service will not result in an expense for the district, as Specialty Care will bill the student's private benefits. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, General Fund, ROI - Full-time students from the SFUMC ECC program are enrolled in the SPS student information system, and count towards our Average Daily Membership (ADM) for state funding.**

**28) Stillwater First United Methodist Church Early Childhood Services Agreement**

Stillwater First United Methodist Church (SFUMC) and Stillwater Public Schools agree to collaborate regarding the requirements of a public school Pre-Kindergarten program and to facilitate the enrollment of four and five-year-old children residing within the boundaries of Stillwater Public Schools. Stillwater Public Schools will provide certain supplemental instructional materials as it deems appropriate. SFUMC will provide enrollment and reporting required by the State of Oklahoma for pupil accounting purposes or

otherwise. The updated MOU reflects a decrease in the per student amount SPS will pay SFUMC ECC from \$1,800 to \$1,200, added language to allow SPS to end the contract if the SFUMC teacher and TA have not completed their OSDE certification process in a timely manner, or if SFUMC does not correctly report student attendance in Campus. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

#### **Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

##### **29) The Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma Mental Health Services Agreement**

Iowa Tribe Behavioral Health is a key partner in delivering school-based mental health services. This ongoing collaboration supports the district's commitment to student wellness by providing on-site counseling, crisis intervention, case management, and family support services. This agreement supports students of all backgrounds—both Native and non-Native—while also expanding culturally responsive access for Native American students and families. We value the opportunity to provide increased mental health support options for our tribal students through this unique partnership.

The continued partnership helps ensure that students have timely access to licensed mental health professionals during the school day, reducing barriers to care and supporting academic and emotional success. SPS recommends approval of this renewed agreement to maintain and strengthen this vital support system for students and families. The updated MOU reflects current roles, expectations, and compliance with all district policies, legal requirements, and confidentiality standards. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

#### **Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

##### **30) The Saville Center for Child Advocacy Physical and Mental Health Services Agreement**

SPS seeks to renew its MOU with The Saville Center for Child Advocacy, a longstanding and trusted partner in supporting child safety and well-being. The Saville Center provides trauma-informed services to children who have experienced or are at risk of abuse or neglect, including forensic interviews, victim advocacy, and coordination with investigative agencies. This agreement ensures that SPS and The Saville Center can continue to collaborate efficiently in cases where student safety is a concern, while maintaining compliance with all legal reporting requirements, confidentiality protections, and student support protocols. Through this partnership, school staff are able to make timely and appropriate referrals, ensuring students and families have access to expert services in times of crisis. The Saville Center also supports the district by offering consultation, training, and resources related to child abuse prevention and trauma-informed practices. SPS recommends approval of the renewed MOU to maintain this essential collaboration and ensure comprehensive support for our students' safety, health, and well-being. No changes from the previous year. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

#### **Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, Federal Fund**

##### **31) Therapy Specialists Speech/Language Evaluation Services Agreement**

Therapy Specialists provide special education evaluations for Occupational Therapy and Speech Language when a parent has requested an Independent Educational Evaluation. They may also provide evaluations for the district during the summer months when employees of the district are not on contract. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

#### **Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

##### **32) United Community Action Program, Inc. Special Services Agreement**

This agreement will provide screening and assessment for all children enrolled in the Head Start as required by the Head Start Program Performance Standards. A Head Start representative will participate in the LEA referral procedures, multidisciplinary evaluation, IEP development, and implementation of the portions of the IEPs identified for the Head Start Program and the IEP review as appropriate. The Head Start will provide a support system for families and children with disabilities through training, information dissemination, and involvement in the program, as well as collaboration with the LEA and other community services. The LEA special education program and Head Start will determine designated program personnel to be responsible for conducting screening within each program to collaboratively implement the requirements of the IDEA and Head Start Performance Standards. Local implementation may incorporate the coordination of shared staff. Screening will be provided for referrals as determined by both entities. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

**33) University of Central Oklahoma** Student Teaching Affiliation Agreement

This agreement between UCO and Stillwater Public Schools concerns the placement of students enrolled in the programs served by the Teacher Education Program within Stillwater Public Schools to complete their required field / clinical experiences as part of their degree program. The students will be required to submit a cleared background check and complete all district-required training. No changes from the previous year. This contract is valid from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

**34) Western Governors University** Student Teaching Affiliation Agreement

This agreement between Western Governors University and Stillwater Public Schools concerns the placement of students enrolled in their education program within Stillwater Public Schools to complete their required field / clinical experiences as part of their degree program. The students will be required to submit a cleared background check and complete all district-required training. No changes from the previous year. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

**Annual Renewal - Existing Contract, No Cost to SPS**

**35) Wings of Hope** Student Enrollment Services Agreement

SPS seeks to renew its partnership with Wings of Hope Family Crisis Services, a local nonprofit agency that provides comprehensive support for individuals and families impacted by domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, and other forms of interpersonal trauma. Through this MOU, SPS and Wings of Hope will collaborate to support students and families in crisis, offer preventive education, and promote healthy relationships through trauma-informed practices and services provided on school campuses and within the community. No changes from the previous year. The term for this contract is July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.
