Overview

- 9th-12th grade students who -
 - failed initial courses needed for graduation or
 - received a NCO for credit-bearing courses.
- Optional; counselors meet with students and parents
- June 3rd - 21st - (4 days/week, 12 days total!)
- Session 1: 9am - Noon; Session 2: 12:30pm - 3:30pm
- 8 certified teachers, 1 EL (p/t), 1 SpEd, 1 HNC (p/t), Office Unicorn



Challenges and Meeting Student Needs

- **64** JH students needed more than **2 credits** in Spring 2024.
- Students need 2.5 credits including Physical Science and English I to attend SHS.
- Edgenuity offers **prescriptive testing** which allows students to demonstrate knowledge in course competencies.
- Credit recovery is competency-based with **no seat time limits** like initial credit courses.
- Students could recover **more than 2 credits** through this model.



Student Demographic Data

- **22%** - students on an IEP
- **12%** - gifted and talented students
- **10%** - students on a 504
- **2%** - identified as McKinney-Vento students
- **10%** - students involved in activities or athletics
- **63%** - students identified as economically disadvantaged
- **0** Lincoln Academy students



Changes for Summer 2024

From This...

- Teacher-prepared lesson packets for each course
- Students completed all required lessons.
- Students must stay at the same pace as all other students.
- Students can only gain 1 full credit.
- Teachers provide whole class lessons before providing support.

To This...

- On-line, virtual platform (Edgenuity) with pre-aligned curriculum
- Students take a prescriptive test to determine knowledge of course competencies and are placed appropriately within the course.
- Students can complete courses at their own pace and gain more than 1 credit.
- Teachers are able to provide one-to-one support for students in real-time.

Completion Rates by Credits

End of Week 1: **57 credits earned**

End of Week 2: **100 credits earned**

End of Week 3 (and total): **186 credits earned**

SS credits are .5 of a course, so this means **93 courses** are completed toward graduation requirements for students!
