RELEASE OF STUDENTS DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

Students are not to be released from school at the request of any person other than the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) with whom they are living, as shown on the enrollment card. The sole exception to this is the release of students to peace officers, DCFS or under a court order.

“School Day” defined:

From the time a student boards the school bus, or arrives at school, until they exit the school bus; or if student is at school at a time after the normal closing of the school office for educational purposes; or until the end of a school sponsored event.
