**CORPORAL PUNISHMENT**

The use of corporal punishment on any student by any staff member of the Nye County School District is expressly prohibited. Corporal punishment means the intentional infliction of physical pain upon or the physical restraint of a pupil for disciplinary purposes. The term does not include the use of reasonable and necessary force: (1) to quell a disturbance that threatens physical injury to any person or the destruction of property; (2) to obtain possession of a weapon or other dangerous object within a pupil's control; (3) for the purpose of self-defense or defense of another person; or (4) to escort a disruptive pupil who refuses to go voluntarily with the proper authorities.

A violation of the Nye County School District's disciplinary code by a student will be dealt with in accordance with existing school and District rules and regulations.
